

## REGISTRATION CONDITIONS

Registration and organisational support for M&PD2026 is provided by medpoint GmbH on behalf of the European Society of Cardiology (ESC).

### ACCESS TO

M&PD2026 is only accessible to certified healthcare professionals, associated press, healthcare industry representatives and other stakeholders involved in the science, management, and prevention of cardiovascular disease. Non-healthcare professionals, including infants and children under the age of 18, will not be able to access the Congress area. Active registrations are nominative and non-transferable.

### PAYMENT AND GENERAL CONDITIONS

All registration fees are quoted in Euro (€) and include 19 % local VAT. Payment in any other currency will not be accepted. Invoices with an address in the European Union should be provided with a VAT Number. The invoicing address and VAT number can only be set up during the registration process. An invoice to an individual cannot be transferred to an organisation after payment. To avoid disappointment, please check the Billing details carefully before payment. If in doubt, contact us.

### PAYMENT OF FEES

Payment can be made online by credit card (Visa or Mastercard) through the online services on our secured server. For security reasons, under no circumstances should credit card details be sent by email. In case of additional payments for extra orders or adjustments, a secured payment link will be sent by email. Registration fees rate is based on the date of receipt of the registration request.

### CANCELLATION BY ATTENDEE

Cancellation of a registration will be subject to the following conditions:

Until Early fee deadline: refund of fee less an administrative charge of 30% of the original fee paid.

After Early fee deadline: no refund.

### MODIFICATION FROM ONSITE TO ONLINE

The booker may change their registration from the onsite event to the online event until one week prior to the event and will be refunded the difference of the original fee paid and online fee at time of change.

### MISCELLANEOUS
